Schedule 1 Scope of Authorisation

The authorisation granted to **Maha Capital Partners LLC** to carry on the regulated activity of Arranging Credit Facilities is restricted to the following specified product:

(a) Credit Facility.

The authorisation granted to **Maha Capital Partners LLC** to carry on the regulated activity of Operating a Collective Investment Fund is restricted to the following specified product:

(a) Units in a Collective Investment Fund.

The authorisation granted to **Maha Capital Partners LLC** to carry on the regulated activities of, Dealing in Investments (as Agent), Managing Investments, Arranging Deals in Investments, Advising on Investments and Arranging the Provision of Custody Services is restricted to the following specified products:

- (a) Shares;
- (b) Debt Instruments;
- (c) Warrants;
- (d) Securities Receipt;
- (e) Units in a Collective Investment Fund;
- (f) Options;
- (g) Futures;
- (h) Contracts for Differences; and
- (i) Rights in Investments.
