Schedule 1 Scope of Authorisation

The authorisation granted to Oman Reinsurance Co. – QFC Branch to carry on the regulated activities of Effecting a Contract of Insurance and Carrying Out a Contract of Insurance is restricted to the following specified products:

General Insurance Contacts, categories:

- (a) 1: Accident;
- (b) 2: Sickness;
- (c) 3: Land vehicles;
- (d) 5: Aircraft;
- (e) 6: Ships;
- (f) 7: Goods in transit;
- (g) 8: Fire and natural forces;
- (h) 9: Damage to property;
- (i) 10: Motor vehicle liability;
- (j) 11: Aircraft liability;
- (k) 12: Liability of ships;
- (I) 13: General liability:
- (m) 14: Credit;
- (n) 16: Miscellaneous financial loss;
- (o) 18: Assistance

The authorisation granted to Oman Reinsurance Co. – QFC Branch to carry on the regulated activity of Insurance Mediation is restricted to giving advice to other persons about the merits of entering into general insurance contracts, whether as principal or agent, in the categories reflected above.
